

Accumulating Rhythms is an ecological artwork that pairs Earth's tidal rhythms with human sentiment on climate at an unprecedented scale.



Accumulating Rhythms will serve as a beacon, inspiring and illuminating our region's commitment to ecological thinking.

Driven by profound rhythms and personal sentiments...

This world-class artwork will juxtapose tidal rhythms with recorded statements sourced from the community, translated into light.

A bold net-zero commitment...

Accumulating Rhythms is committed to achieving net-zero operational and embodied carbon through hyper-local offsets. To achieve this, we will partner with outstanding environmental justice and energy-transition organizations based right here - in the shadow of the bridge.

WHAT'S REQUIRED

The artwork consists of a series of state-of-the-art lighting fixtures, networked together and governed by custom programming.

Weaving the Earth's most profound rhythms with thousands of voices transformed into light.

Leading up to and throughout the artwork's deployment, the artists' team with local partners will conduct workshops on tide and ecology. Participants will be invited to share their thoughts on climate by offering a recording of their voice to the project. Thousands of recordings over the life of the project will constitute an evolving repository; thoughts, fears, hopes, visions for our shared ecology.

The artists will then analyze the rhythm, texture and tone of these statements and translate them into abstract lighting patterns to be displayed on the bridge at immense scale. The result is an ever-evolving series of lighting events cast across the bridge, with viewers observing layers of color and rhythmical motifs.

At the intersection of infrastructure, culture and environment, *Accumulating Rhythms* will be a legible tide clock and a living chronicle of climate sentiment.





THE PATH



Building on our region's legacy of climate action, Accumulating Rhythms is a bold commitment to engaging as many people and communities as can be reached in a sustained climate conversation at the threshold of a critical decade ahead.

Accumulating Rhythms is estimated to be illuminated for five-to-ten years. The piece will continue to broadcast our regional commitment to climate awareness over the Mystic River nightly, cresting Boston's 400th anniversary and carrying over into the start of a pivotal era for climate action.
